First-time setup the CITI "refresher" course

Before you do anything else, please open a duplicate of **these instructions** in another browser window.

For internet Explorer, click the "File" command on the menu as shown in the picture at left. (Your screen will look similar, but not exactly like this.) Select "New Window" from the dropdown menu.

Access the CITI training website @ CLICK HERE

This will take you to the CITI site. Please rearrange you windows so you can see the CITI website in the window you just opened, and can also see **these instructions** (which should still be open) in another window. That way, you can refer to the instructions as you set-up your training.

Once on the CITI website, click the "Click here to register" link, as shown below.



Step 1

Pick "Loma Linda University" from the dropdown menu:

- Click the arrow, then type in the letter "L" to find Loma Linda University
- . Make sure Loma Linda University shows in the box
- Click "Continue"



Steps 2 through 4 are self-explanatory

Step 5 Refers to receiving *professional* CEU.

This IS NOT the same thing as the "internal" credit you receive at Loma Linda University Health to fulfill the human research subjects protections training requirement.

If you want to also receive professional CEUs for completing CITI training, click the appropriate boxes and CITI will provide you the additional information about that. Be advised that CITI (not LLU) does **charge money** for CEU's issued.

Step 6 can be dispensed with quickly by entering the information in only the three *required* fields: institutional email, Department, and Role in Research (if Department is not applicable, just type "N/A")
